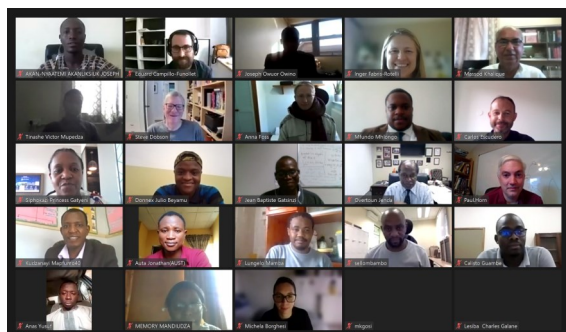

Symposium Theme: “Mathematics Connecting to One Health”

We will highlight the previous work done by the network and work on future collaborative research areas and knowledge transfer. By using mathematical and statistical tools and research teams from different disciplines and geographical areas, as well as utilizing policy makers and practitioners, we can inform policy and practices to improve the health of all.
